RESOLUTION DECLARING LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY

Minutes of a regular meeting of the Township Board of the Charter Township of Chesterfield, County of Macomb, Michigan held in the Township municipal offices in Chesterfield Township on March 17, 2020 at 7:00 P.M., Eastern Standard Time.

PRESENT: Acciavatti, Berry, Lafata, Anderson, DeMuynck, Joseph, and Vosburg

ABSENT: None

The following preamble and resolution were offered by Member Berry and supported by Member Vosburg.

WHEREAS, On March 10, 2020, the Governor of the State of Michigan declared a State of Emergency pursuant to her authority under the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and the Emergency Management Act ("EMA"), being Act 390, Public Acts of 1976, as amended, to combat the spread of the Coronavirus Disease ("COVID-19"), given the severity of the risk posed to the public and considering the public health recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention ("CDC"); and

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, President Donald J. Trump issued a Proclamation Declaring a National Emergency Concerning the Novel Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) Outbreak, finding and proclaiming that the COVID-19 outbreak in the United States constitutes a national emergency; and

WHEREAS, Section 10 of the EMA provides that each municipality that has appointed an emergency management coordinator under the EMA may declare a local state of emergency in circumstances within the municipality when an occurrence or threat of widespread or severe damage, injury, loss of life or property from a natural or man-made cause exists; and

WHEREAS, Section 10 of the EMA provides that the power to declare a local state of emergency shall vest in the chief executive officer of the municipality and shall not be continued or renewed for a period in excess of seven (7) days except with the consent of the governing body of the municipality; and

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, the Township Supervisor declared a local state of emergency pursuant to Section 10 of the EMA; and

WHEREAS, circumstances within the Township indicate that the occurrence or threat of widespread or severe damage, injury or loss of life from the spread of COVID-19 exists and it is therefore necessary to extend the Local State of Emergency Declaration until June 15, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF CHESTERFIELD, MACOMB COUNTY, MICHIGAN:

1. The Local State of Emergency Declaration issued on March 16, 2020 pursuant to Section 10 of the EMA is hereby extended until June 15, 2020.
2. The Township Emergency Management Coordinator, in consultation with the Township Supervisor, shall be vested with all powers set forth in the EMA.


