Chesterfield Township Approves Special Vending Permit

CHESTERFIELD TOWNSHIP, MI- On Tuesday, June 2, 2020 the Chesterfield Township Board of Trustees voted unanimously to relax standards and provide a streamlined process for bar and restaurant establishments interested in expanding seating capacity outdoors.

The proposal was brought forward by township planning administrator, Jonathan Palin and Clerk Cindy Berry in an effort to provide relief to businesses that face reduced capacity restrictions imposed by Governor Whitmer's executive order.

The special vending permit will be valid for a maximum of 90 days from the date of issuance. All bond requirements normally associated with vending, electrical or sign permits under this application are waived, although all normal permit fees still apply. Every effort will be made to expedite the processing of these applications.

Businesses interested in applying for the Outdoor Dining vending permit may contact the Clerk's office or visit the Chesterfield Township website for a link to the application package.
