CALL TO ORDER: Chairman Tom Yaschen called the Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

OLD BUSINESS:

- E)** Additional Items - Tom Y. has planted a Northern King Maple at the Township Office in honor of all the efforts of the Beautification Committee. As it grows he will arrange for a plaque.

NEW BUSINESS:

- A)** Facebook – Richard P. has asked his new assistant to start a new site and maintain it for the Committee. Tom Y. will add this as an Agenda item for everyone’s input at the August meeting.
- B)** Chesterfield Beautification Committee 40 Years - Sue has made arrangements to have the 40th Anniversary Plate framed; however, the Committee concurred that if Wayne N. can cut some local wood (ash) to have a frame made by a local

frame maker (John Lanman), that would add a community touch. Cindy B. will call and see if he would volunteer to make the frame. He has made other frames for the Township. Wayne N. also said he could cut some local wood to be used for a bench under the historical display. Sue G. will do some homework on the history of the Committee. Cindy B. will search the Township archives for additional historical information. Already we have learned that John and Marie Michaelson (sp?) were founding members.
