


Brandenburg Park Site Rentals

Brandenburg Park is a waterfront park positioned on the shoreline of Anchor Bay. This 17-acre parcel offers basketball courts, tennis courts, sand volleyball courts, horseshoe pits, picnic areas, boat launches, restroom facilities, a children's play area, a hike/bike path and a 500 foot pier extending into Lake St. Clair. With a total of 16 fountains, the Splash Park is a fun and exciting way for your child to spend a hot summer the day! This park has four open air pavilions with electrical outlets and a building that accommodates 70 people. Pavilion rentals are \$150 each (June-August), the air conditioned building rents for \$200 (June-August). Facilities are available for rent year-round, but off-season rates may apply. Call 586-949-0400 ext. 4 for September-May pricing. Consider Brandenburg Park when reserving a site for your next party! \$5 Per Car or \$10 Per Bus, park entry fee required (May-September).

Registration Procedures

- 1) Residents are individuals who live or own property in Chesterfield Township. Documentation may be requested (driver's license, tax bill or utility bill), if there is a question on the validity of residency status will continue until a program has reached its maximum capacity. Non-residents are encouraged to enroll, but in most cases pay an additional fee of \$5 per person, per program.
- 2) Registrations are accepted Monday-Friday, 8AM-4:30PM at the Dept. of Parks and Recreation located inside of the Chesterfield Township Municipal Offices at 47275 Sugarbush (Between Cotton and 21 Mile Road). Registration forms can be obtained via the departmental website, parks.chesterfieldtwp.org. Registrations are also accepted online at, parks.chesterfieldtwp.org.
- 3) Walk-in registrations will be processed immediately. Registrations may be mailed to Chesterfield Township Parks and Recreation, 47275 Sugarbush, Chesterfield, MI. 48047. After hour registrations may be placed in the Drop Box located outside of the Chesterfield Township Municipal Offices. Both mail-in & drop box registrations will be processed when received by parks and recreation staff and may not be processed for several days. Mail-in & Drop Box registrations received prior to the first day of registration may be returned to sender.
- 4) Registrations must be accompanied by full payment, completed registration form(s), and participant or parent/guardian signature in order to be processed. Check, cash, VISA/MASTERCARD/DISCOVER accepted however, credit/debit cards will only be accepted onsite. There is a \$20 minimum charge for credit/debit purchases. Personal checks cannot be accepted for amusement park ticket sales and bus trips. Make checks payable to: Chesterfield Township.
- 5) AGE GUIDELINES: For programs, participants must be the designated age or turning it during the program in order to participate. For leagues, participants' birthdates must coincide with designated age requirements. For programs & leagues using grade requirements, the participant must be in the designated grade when the program takes place. During summer break, a child should be enrolled in programs & leagues corresponding with the grade he/she will be entering in the fall. A child will not be permitted to participate if the above guidelines are not met. Our dept. reserves the right to request proof of age/grade.
