RE: Salt River Bridge Closure

Dear Resident,

The Macomb County Department of Roads (MCDR) will begin construction on the Salt River Bridge over Jefferson Avenue beginning February 2019; with completion anticipated at the end of June. As we start to prepare for this construction in our Township, please remember that all road traffic along Jefferson will be redirected and that access through the waterway cannot be guaranteed as it will remain restricted for the safety of boaters as well as the construction workers. To provide you with more information on the project, we have included a letter we received from the MCDR regarding the water craft traffic as well as a current rendering of the bridge.

While we are excited to have a new bridge over the Salt River waterway, we do apologize for any inconvenience that this will have on your 2019 boating season. The Macomb County Department of Roads (MCDR) is in the Final Design phase for the replacement of the Jefferson Avenue over Salt River bridge project. This project will be advertised for bid shortly and scheduled to begin construction in February of 2019, with completion anticipated near the end of June 2019. Once construction begins, Jefferson Avenue will be closed to all through traffic, both roadway and waterway.

Residents should plan to store their water craft appropriately as access under Jefferson Avenue will not be allowed until construction is completed. While some may feel that crossing while the superstructure is removed or after beams have been placed is acceptable, it is still highly recommended that water craft access remain restricted for the safety of boaters as well as the construction workers.

- Estimate bid letting date January 2017

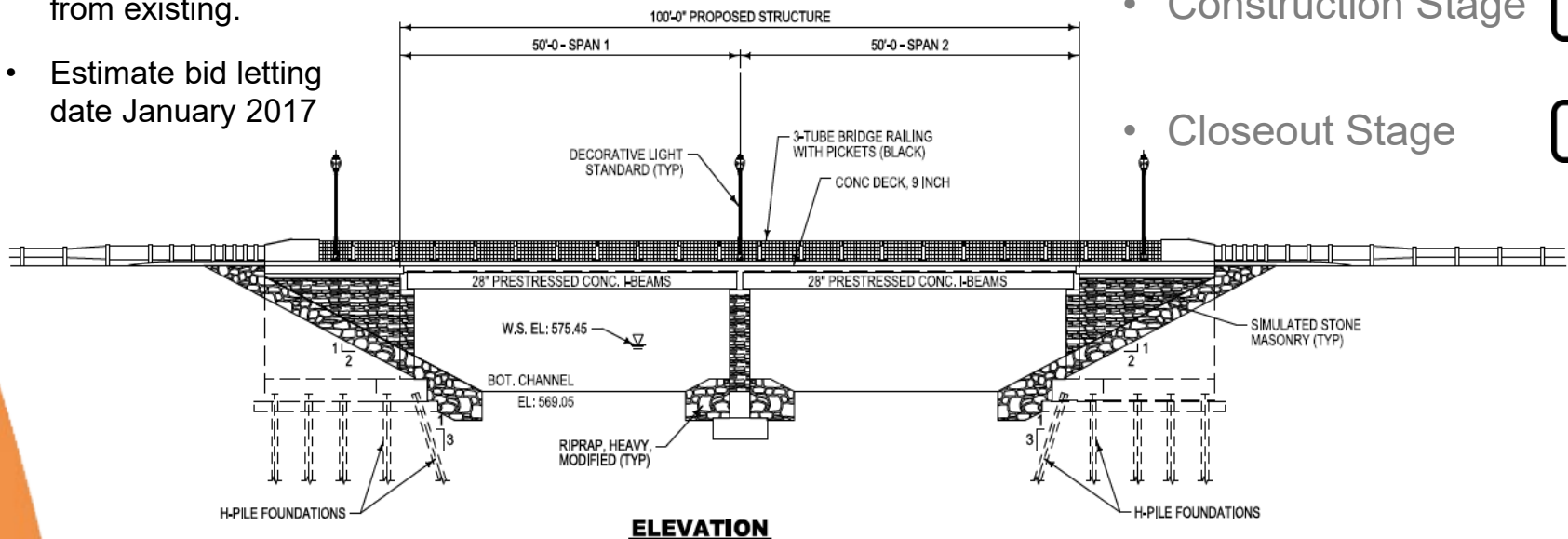
