This transmittal and attachments are intended to outline and update the residents of Chesterfield Township in relation to our single waste hauler vendor, Green for Life (GFL). I am painfully aware of all of the issues relating to this service and vendor, and share in your frustration.

I have included many attachments detailing the process that was used to procure this vendor last year. The fact that this contract was procured and extended multiple times in the past, with a cloud of corruption, weighed heavily on my mind throughout the procurement process.

Attachment # 1: 2018.1.22 Single Waste Hauler BOT Discussion. This is the package I presented to the Township Board of Trustees prior to proceeding with procurement. It was clear to me and the entire Board of Trustees due to the fact that this vendor has not been bid out since 2005, and was extended three times with no bid contracts that Chesterfield Township needed to go out for sealed bids. The board of trustees approved that direction and the team proceeded with the procurement process.

Attachment # 2 2018.6.18 Request for Bids BOT Agenda Item. The attached Request for Bids package was drafted in concert with the Township attorney by the procurement team for the Township Single Waste Hauler contract.
