The Jefferson Road / Salt River Bridge replacement project has been under construction since last spring. I would like to thank you for your patience and understanding as Chesterfield Township coordinates with the Macomb County Department of Roads on this vitally important project. Below is a statement from the Macomb County Department of Roads on the Status of the project.

Jefferson Avenue Bridge project update from the Macomb County Department of Roads

“Due to weather and unexpected project challenges, the open date for the Jefferson Avenue Bridge over the Salt River has been delayed. We apologize for any inconvenience and appreciate your understanding. With more than 25 road and bridge improvement projects throughout Macomb County, it is unavoidable that some projects will experience delays. We are working with our contractor to complete the work and reopen the bridge in a timely manner. The Macomb County Department of Roads will continue to keep residents and motorists updated on the progress of the project. Thank you.”

Project Information:

When complete, this bridge will be aesthetically pleasing; will result in a slight increase in water clearance, include a 10’ wide non-motorized path, and a decorative railing with lighting along with a new water main crossing under the Salt River. The project also includes a complete reconstruction of approximately 600 feet of Jefferson Avenue along with the connection of the Non-Motorized path to the new bridge. I expect the structure to be a source of pride for our community for decades. I again thank you for your patience during the construction process.
