## Resolution 2021-09

### RESOLUTION EXTENDING DECLARATION OF LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY

Minutes of a regular meeting of the Township Board of the Charter Township of Chesterfield, County of Macomb, Michigan held in the Township municipal offices in Chesterfield Township on April 13, 2021 at 7:00 P.M., Eastern Standard Time.

**PRESENT: Members Acciavatti, Berry, Elliott, Anderson, DeMuyneck, Joseph and Vosburg**

**ABSENT: None**

The following preamble and resolution were offered by Member **Vosburg** and supported by Member **Berry**.

**WHEREAS**, this Resolution is adopted pursuant to the Emergency Management Act ("EMA"), being Act 390, Public Acts of 1976, as amended in response to the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19); and its variants including B.1.1.7; and

**WHEREAS**, COVID-19 is a respiratory disease that can result in serious illness or death and is caused by a strain of coronavirus not previously identified in humans and easily spreads from person to person. COVID-19 spreads through close human contact even from individuals who may be asymptomatic; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 10 of the EMA provides that each municipality that has appointed an emergency management coordinator under the EMA may declare a local state of emergency in circumstances within the municipality when an occurrence or threat



of widespread or severe damage, injury, loss of life or property from a natural or man-made cause exists; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 10 of the EMA provides that the power to declare a local state of emergency shall vest in the chief executive officer of the municipality and shall not be continued or renewed for a period in excess of seven (7) days except with the consent of the governing body of the municipality; and

**WHEREAS**, on April 5, 2021, the Township Supervisor declared a local state of emergency, effective April 7, 2021, pursuant to Section 10 of the EMA; and

**WHEREAS**, circumstances within the Township indicate that the occurrence or threat of widespread or severe damage, injury or loss of life from the spread of COVID-19 and its variants still exists, and it is therefore necessary to extend the Local State of Emergency Declaration until **June 01, 2021**.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF CHESTERFIELD, MACOMB COUNTY, MICHIGAN:**


1. The Local State of Emergency Declaration issued on April 5, 2021 pursuant to Section 10 of the EMA is hereby extended until **June 01, 2021**.
2. The Township emergency management coordinator, in consultation with the Township Supervisor, shall be vested with all powers set forth in the EMA.
