Chesterfield Township governmental structure is organized to reflect the Charter Township format, with a governing board elected by the people and led by a Township Supervisor. Each of the full-time Elected Officials, Supervisor, Clerk and Treasurer, oversee their respective office. In addition to these statutory offices, daily operations of the township are carried out by division Department Heads.

Chesterfield Township Board of Trustee meetings are held publicly twice monthly. We encourage you to share your knowledge, ask questions, participate in discussions, and become an integral part of the community dialogue.

The future of Chesterfield Township is bright with a Master Plan that addresses future land use, community development and other items. It is intended to guide development in the township over a period of 10 to 20 years.
